Subject: - 2nd renewal of permission to Baba Khetanath Govt. Ayurvedic College and Hospital, village-Pattikara, Narnaul, Dist- Mahendragarh, Narnaul- 123001, Haryana (Inst. ID. AYU0714) with 30 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Baba Khetanath Govt. Ayurvedic College and Hospital, village-Pattikara, Narnaul, Dist- Mahendragarh, Narnaul- 123001, Haryana (Inst. ID. AYU0714)**, inspection of your College was conducted on **06.03.2024 & 07.03.2024 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **2nd renewal of Conditional Permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25, under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
- Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **96th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **05.07.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no. dated 16.07.2024** to appear on **19.07.2024** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the 2nd renewal of conditional permission to your college with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the academic year 2024-25.**
4. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide ref no. NCISM/2024/1819 dated 17.07.2024.** against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Principal Professor Dr. Shriniwas Gujjarwar has attended the hearing.** Appeared before the Hearing Committee on **19.07.2024** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. 6. In view of above, the matter **was placed in the 104th Board meeting of MARBISM held on 28.08.2024** and Board concluded that the college **is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for Conditional Permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 29 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25. However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2024-25.**

For UG course:- as per the seat reduction policy :-

- a) **"For deficiency of every one teacher, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 5% of total intake capacity."**

Accordingly as per Schedule-V Note (iv) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to hundred intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the approval of Minutes in the 104th Board meeting of MARBISM, college is having only 06 total eligible Teaching faculties.

There is deficiency of 14 teachers for issuance of conditional permission for academic session 2024-25 as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. **Therefore, in accordance of Reduction policy 2024-2025, for deficiency of 14 teachers, seat reduction in the intake capacity is considered by reducing the intake strength by 70% of total intake capacity.**

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2024-25 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 and, college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **2nd renewal of permission with 30 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.**

7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and after applying seat reduction policy for the academic year 2024-25, **2nd renewal of Permission is issued to Baba Khetanath Govt. Ayurvedic College and Hospital, village-Pattikara, Narnaul, Dist- Mahendragarh, Narnaul-123001, Haryana (Inst. ID. AYU0714) with 30 seats (instead of 100 seats) in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under for the academic session 2024-25.**

- i. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 30 seats (instead of 100 seats)** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not

maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
12. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of the 4th batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS is made, under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
13. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time as per the norms which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
14. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
15. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
